Bal Sahyog provides round the clock services of shelter, nutrition, medical care, clothing, education, vocational training, recreational and over all amenities to more than 125 children within its Children's Home. Honorable Prime Minister of India is the Patron of Bal Sahyog.

In its endeavor to holistic development of children in need and collective action, Bal Sahyog has been networking and collaborating with different child care Institutions, government Institutions, law enforcement agencies, donor agencies, non-government organizations, civil society organizations, opinion makers and individuals for the same. It is located in a campus of 1.67 acres in Connaught Place, New Delhi.



It has also established Bal Sahyog Middle School aided by Govt. of NCT of Delhi within its campus. Bal Sahyog is governed by General Committee of 25-30 members nominated by the Prime Minister Office. These members are eminent persons from different fields including current and retired bureaucrats, academicians and social workers.

SUCCESS STORY

Bal Sahyog, a beacon of hope for marginalized communities, has been a powerful force in transforming the lives of thousands of underprivileged children, women, and youth in the slums of Delhi. What started as a small initiative to provide care for orphaned and abandoned children has now blossomed into a comprehensive social support system that extends to entire communities, uplifting them through education, health services, vocational training, and more.

EMPOWERING CHILDREN: A SAFE HAVEN

The organization's Home serve as lifelines, offering a safe space where children are not only protected but also nurtured. Bal Sahyog cater children who have been abandoned, orphaned, or are at risk of neglect and exploitation. One of the success stories that stands out is that of Chandan, whose journey is a testament to resilience and determination. According to his case file, his mother, residing in a village in Bihar, battles a psychological disorder, while his father, who is disabled, lives on the streets of Delhi.



Chandan, along with his younger brother, arrived at Bal Sahyog Children's Home in April 2018. Despite the hardships he faced, Chandan remained focused on his education, excelling with exceptional grades.

With the support of Bal Sahyog, he not only completed his schooling but also excelled in her academics. His consistent performance earned him a scholarship each year, along with a monthly reward of Rs. 500 from the Bal Sahyog management. When he turned 18, in October 2022, he was restored to his family. However, his ambition did not stop there. Chandan cleared the CUET (Common University Entrance Test) with high marks, securing a spot in the regular courses at Delhi University. Now, in his third year of B.Com, he is balancing his studies with an internship as an accountant at a CA firm, showcasing both his academic and professional dedication. He attributes his transformation to the unwavering care and support he received from Bal Sahyog, stating, "Bal Sahyog gave me a second chance at life."

EDUCATION AND HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT

Over the years, Bal Sahyog has witnessed remarkable transformations. Laxman, a former child of Bal Sahyog, had always dreamed of becoming a banker. Raised by his mother in a financially struggling household, he faced many challenges from an early age. Thanks to the sponsorship and educational support he received, from Bal Sahyog. Here, he received essential support in the form of education, food, shelter, clothing, and, most importantly, affection.

His academic dedication earned him a scholarship from generous donors, Mr. Kunal Sumani and Ms. Anjali Makhija, which helped him continue his studies. Laxman excelled in his Class X board exams, achieving an impressive 84%, and later graduated from Satyawati College at Delhi University. Today, Laxman works as a Subject Matter Expert (SME) at RBL Bank, earning a stable income and contributing financially to his family, a shining example

CHILDREN HOME

About:

During the last 6 months 66 children stayed at Bal Sahyog Shelter Home, out of which 9 children were successfully restored to their families from the order of CWC (Child welfare Committee or after they completed 18 years of age.

Bal Sahyog runs a Children's Home for 125 children consisting of a Shelter Home for 100 children and an Open Shelter for 25 children. It also runs a Middle School for providing education to the children of Shelter Home and immediate neighborhood for class VI, VII and VIII. An eight bedded dispensary for taking care of the health needs, a well-furnished modular kitchen, large dining hall and sufficient space for recreation and sports, etc. have been provided on its campus at Connaught Place for the children of the Bal Sahyog.

OPEN SHELTER

About:
During the last 6 months 72 children stayed at Bal Sahyog Shelter Home, out of which 38 children were successfully restored to their families.

The children in need of care and protection are provided with health care, counseling support and opportunity for residential stay for a short time at Bal Sahyog. These children are brought in from the nearby locality and produced before the Child Welfare Committee (CWC) where the first choice is made with the child's best interest as its top priority.

Total 100 beneficiaries studying in class 1st to 12th were provided tuition classes by 8 tutors, in the last six months. A drawing and painting competition was also organized by Tech Mahindra Foundation at Bal Sahyog, Connaught Place.

Computer Literacy Program for Under-Privileged Children

Bal Sahyog is currently operating the vocational "Computer Training Programme" with support from the Tech Mahindra Foundation to assist adolescents, men, and women learn basic computer skills at the contact centres at various places throughout Delhi, specifically at Karol Bagh, Wazirpur, and Connaught Place. The fact that more than 150 children in the last six months received training in the fundamentals of computers is a major accomplishment for them as well as for us.
