URMILA is a 20 years unmarried girl and belongs from U.P. She is living in Rithala with her parents and 2 sisters. Her sister is deaf & dumb .Her father is working in a factory and drawing a very meager salary. She also has a little defect her leg. She is very well



behaved, hardworking & brilliant student. During the course she learned – drafting, paper pattern, cutting, stitching and so on.

After the completing the course, she has started cutting & tailoring work in her own house with two machines. She got very good response from the locality. Now she is earning between 4-5 thousands each month. In future she wants to open a cutting & tailoring center of her own. She owes her success to team of Bal Sahyog & Tech Mahindra and is profoundly grateful to them for helping her to stand on her legs. In her own words "BAL SAHYOG has made me strong & changed my life.
